Benefits of Membership

Increased advocacy through collective strength - Solar industry professionals have the collective influence to advocate for improving solar related policies and participate in the regulatory process. MOSEIA's Government Affairs team represents the Missouri solar industry at the State Capitol each session and at the court level when necessary.

Shape policies, procedures and priorities - There are opportunities for members to engage in a variety of ways including board positions and committee involvement.

Professional development tuition discounts - Discount registration on MOSEIA hosted professional development. Friends of Solar individual and student categories may only purchase one ticket per event.

Annual Conference/Evening Social - a member only event and the state's largest solar event of the year. Programming includes prominent national speakers, awards luncheon, policy updates, networking with exhibiting sponsors and a board of directors election.

News and Information - Our industry-focused e-mail updates and social media posts inform members of policy action alerts and the latest solar PV installs and developments.

Website Recognition - each membership, excluding Friends of Solar (individual/student) receives a website logo listing.

Membership Categories and Levels - check appropriate category.

General Membership - Solar Installers, Distributors, Manufacturers, Solar Specific Financial Institutions, Real Estate Developers and Property Managers with solar integrated projects.

\$1,000 6 - 10 employees

\$1,500 11 - 20 employees

\$2,000 21 - 25 employees

\$2,500 26 - 29 employees

\$3,000 over 30 employees

Employee count based on total employees including full time equivalent independent and sub-contractors. Includes the right to one vote, hold office and chair committees.

Non-Profit - \$500

Non-profit institutions or non-governmental entities utilizing solar energy or promoting solar energy. Excludes trade schools, community colleges and universities. Includes the right to one vote, hold office and chair committees.

Associate - \$250

Service category including: Energy audit professionals, architects, engineering and legal firms, government agencies, crane operators and accredited educational institutions. Solar installation companies or employees of those companies are not eligible. Non-voting membership and not eligible to hold office or chair committees.

Friends of Solar - \$50

Friends of Solar is an individual membership. Qualifying entities include: residential system owners, commercial system owners, individuals, and students enrolled in an accredited educational institution. Non-voting membership and not eligible to hold office or chair committees. Employees of solar or electrical businesses are not eligible for this membership category.
